Ecdysis is a series of seven birch boxes which contains a dream and rebirth.

Birch trunk,
Urushi lacquer,
ethically sourced recycled sterling silver 950,
organic cotton thread,
vegetable tanned leather,
human hair,
poem typed on self-made vegetal paper,
delivered in a recycled eco-friendly carboard box,
H 10cm to 15 cm; Ø 7cm

Ecdysis | I to VII | Price guideline

I believe art is not an elitist media, I want art to be affordable in the limit of sustainability for the artist. This is why I created a system of pricing which is more a system of support than establishing a definitive price for an object. I am building this system in the attempt to extract my practice from the rules of a consumerist market and its ideology. This is a work in progress, any remark or discussion is more than welcome.

This how I set three price for one object (to which you'll have to add the shipping price depending on your location):

1) Covering

Which is covering all the non-moveable costs of raw materials and transportation to find the said material

2) Confirming

Which is covering all the non-moveable costs of materials and transportation to find the said material + The cost of the time spent to make the object and update the website according to the hourly minimum wage in France (10€/hour).

3) Supporting

Which is covering all the non-moveable costs of materials and transportation to find the said material + The cost of the time spent to make the object and update the website according to the <u>hourly wage</u> corresponding to my degree in France ($74 \in$ /hour).

The customer can then choose a price regarding his/her own income and/or how he/she wants to support the artist. Once it is settled the customer will receive the final invoice. The object will be sent when the payment is completed.

1) Covering = 92,61 €

Which is covering all the non-moveable costs of raw materials and transportation to find the said material

2) Confirming = 942,61 €

Which is covering all the non-moveable costs of materials and transportation to find the said material + The cost of the time spent to make the object and update the website according to the hourly minimum wage in France (10€/hour).

^{*}This is an estimate regarding the time spent. The Urushi lacquer technique demands patience and time. There are over 20 layers of lacquer. Each layer demands at last 24 hours to dry. Each layer demands to be carefully sanded, cleaned and for the last polished. These boxes (between collecting them, drying the wood and applying the lacquer) took me 2 years to finish.

3) Supporting = 6 382,61 €

Which is covering all the non-moveable costs of materials and transportation to find the said material + The cost of the time spent to make the object and update the website according to the <u>hourly wage</u> corresponding to my degree in France (74€/hour).
